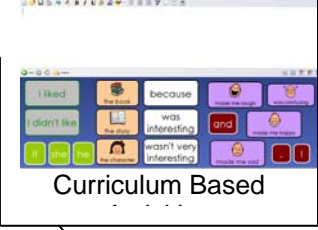

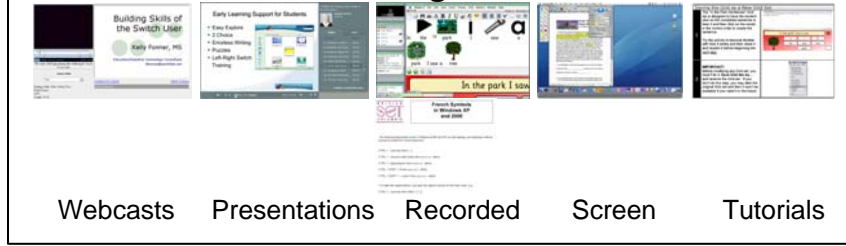

### ▪ Accessible Books ▪

For students who struggle with conventional print books, these books with graphics and sound provide a motivating literacy experience. Over 500 books, both copyrighted and copyright-free, are available, on order, to BC educators working with students with perceptual or physical disabilities. The books have been created using Clicker, PowerPoint and Classroom Suite. For those outside of British Columbia, Free Books for You can be downloaded from this area of the site.

### ▪ curriculumSET ▪

This collection of downloadable, technology-based resources, created by educators, is designed to support the K-12 curriculum. These resources utilize the power of applications like Clicker, Classroom Suite and SOLO to provide students at the beginning and developing stages of literacy with interactive learning environments in a variety of subject areas. The activities can be used “as is” or modified to suite your individual students’ needs. Creating your own activities? Please contribute to this growing collection!

### ▪ pictureSET ▪

This collection contains resources that can be used for both receptive and expressive communication. Anyone can search the database and download ready-made PCS based schedules, activities, and social stories. The collection includes over 1000 files in both Boardmaker and .pdf format organized in topics such as Community, Health, Holidays, Home and School. All pictureSET resources are created and updated by educators working directly with students.

### ▪ Learning Centre ▪

The SET-BC Learning Centre contains a vast number of online resources designed to help educators effectively implement assistive technology with a wide variety of students. These resources include webcasts by well known AT presenters, presentations on general or specific AT topics, recorded training sessions on AT software, narrated screen demonstrations, and downloadable tutorials and tip sheets. The resources are organized alphabetically and can be searched by keyword. New resources are added all the time, so check this area frequently!
